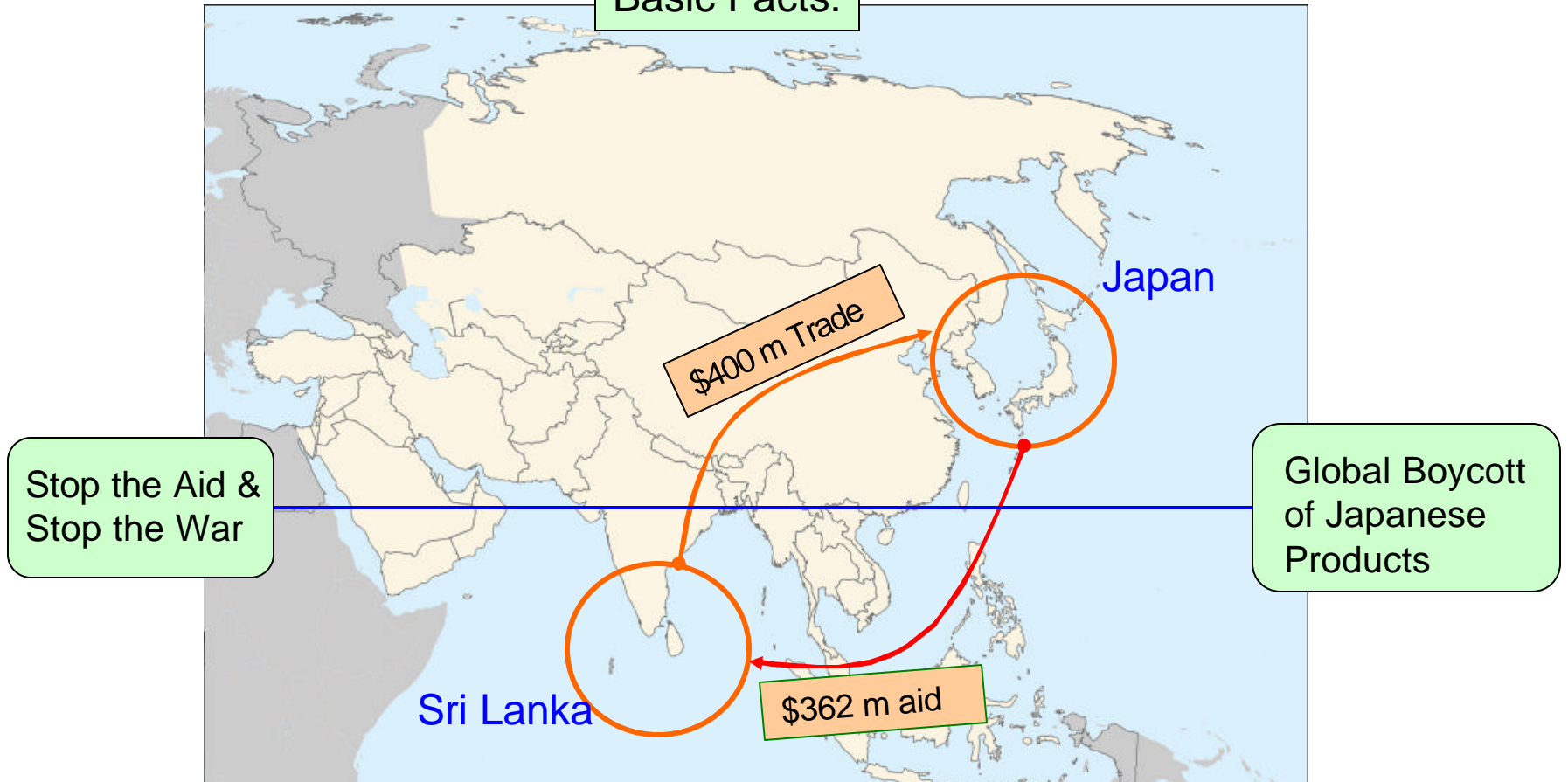


Japan-Sri Lanka: Aiding War Against Tamils

Basic Facts:



- 85,000 Tamil Civilians Killed + Disappeared 1983-2009
- 2 Year Bombing of Tamil Homeland = 1 A-Bomb on Hiroshima
- Genocide of Tamils in Sri Lanka is Fueled by Foreign Aid
- Japan at UN Limits Open Debate on War against Tamils

Development Funds 2008- \$890 million

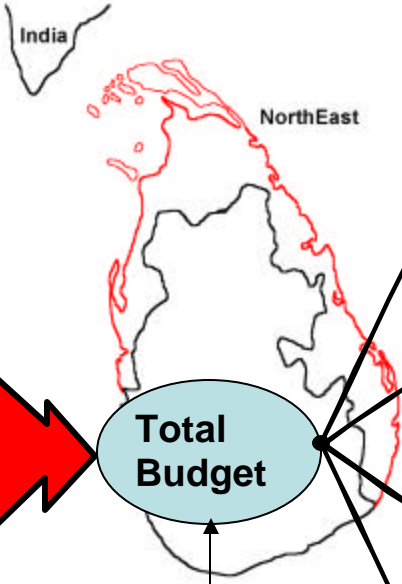

- No vigorous support for Tamils at UN
- Down played IDP problem at UN
- Articulated the strategy of Vanni invasion
- Blamed LTTE for the complex situation
- Defeating LTTE at civilian cost acceptable

- Visited Tamil Eelam 2002-2006
- Met LTTE Leaders multiple times
- Joined call to lay down arms & surrender in 2009
- Placed no condition on SL aid

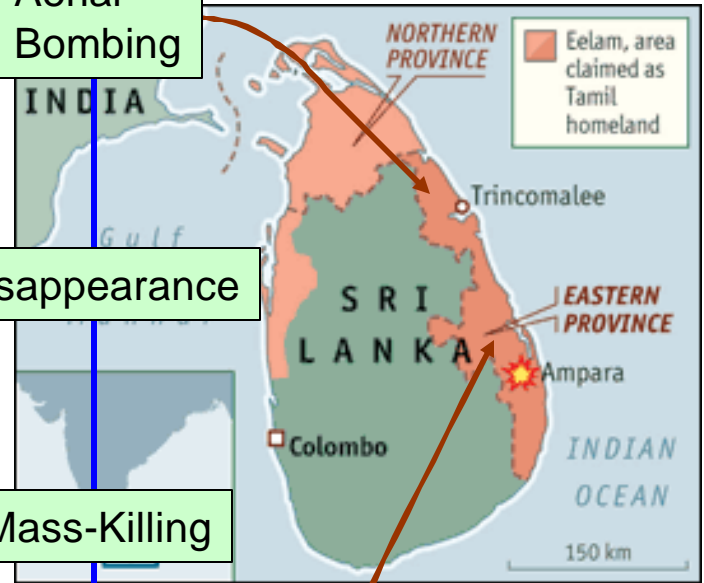

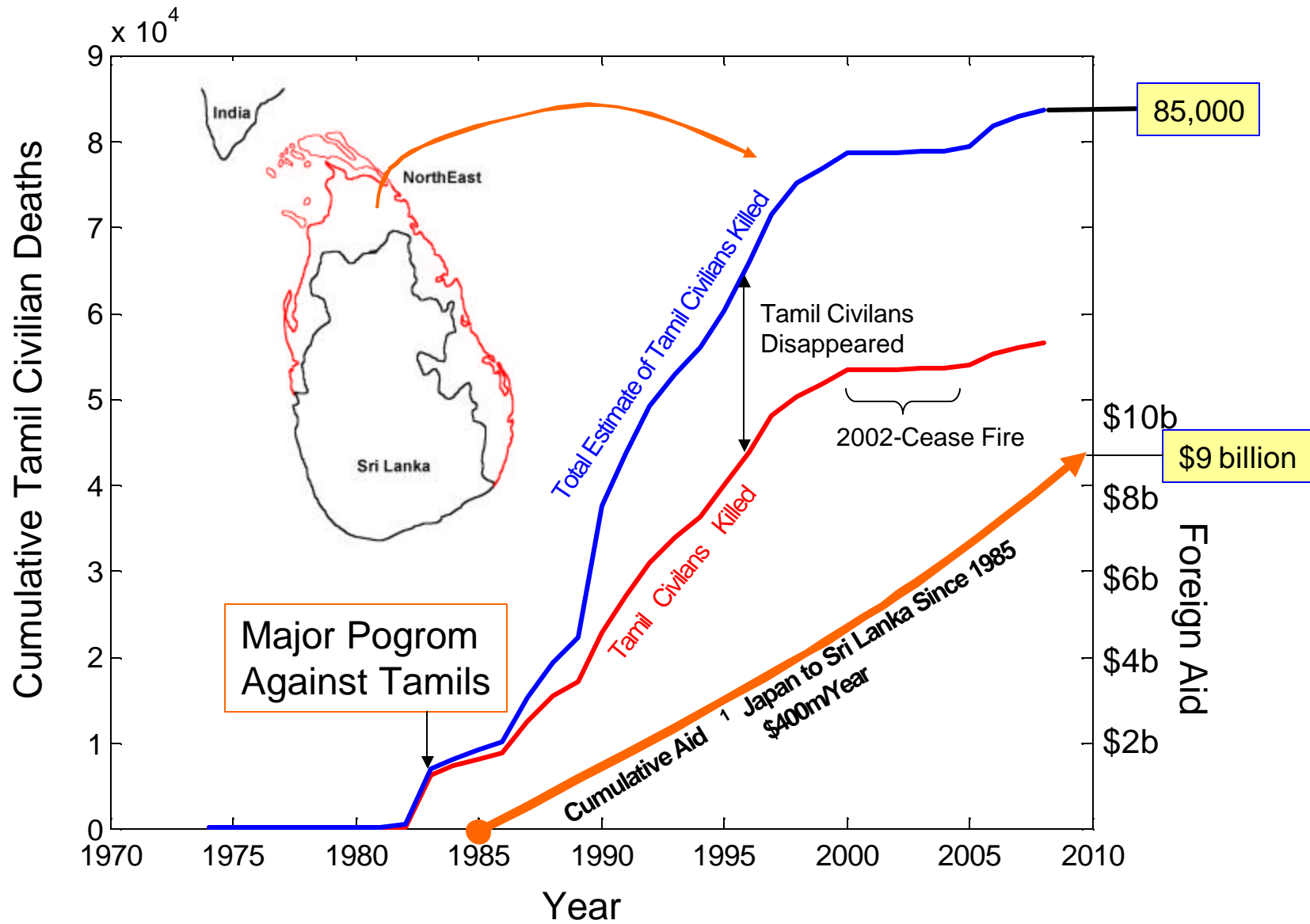

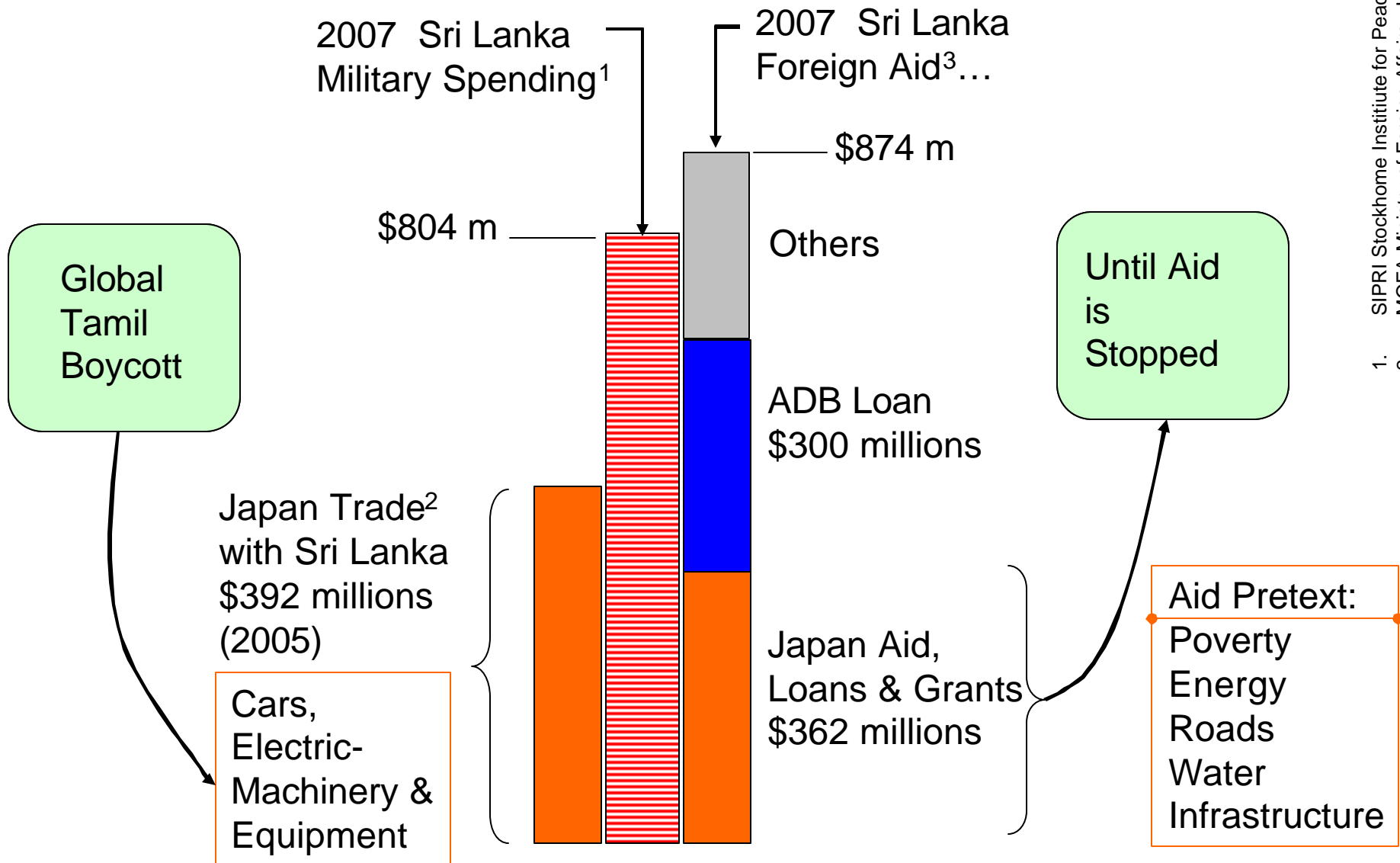


Tamil Civilians Killed in the Northeast Compared to Japan Aid to Sri Lanka

Japan's Trade & Aid to Sri Lanka Facilitates Genocidal War on Tamils

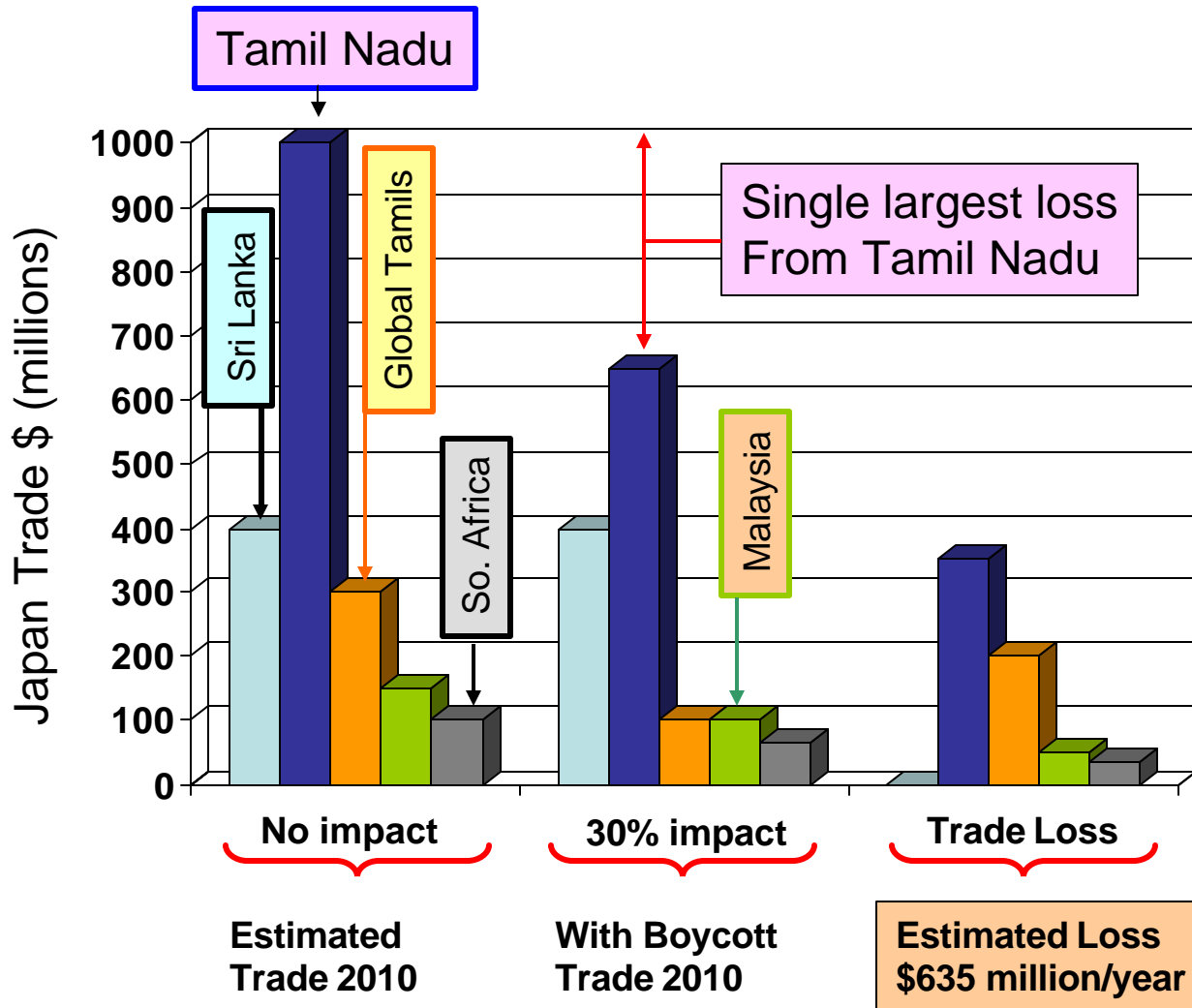

Trade Impact from Global Tamil Boycott: Rough Estimate for 2010



- No impact in Sri Lanka: Sinhalese Keep buying / Tamils Intimidated to buy
- 30% Drop in the purchase of high value Japanese Products=> \$635 m Loss
