

Resolution – Grand Bay, Mauritius – November 10th 2013

Following the United Nations Internal Review, the Secretary General of the United Nations accepted that “the UN failed to protect the Tamil people in the island of Sri Lanka adding that he was not supported by the UN member states”, which led to the mass atrocities. Also, he stated that this failure should be a lesson for the UN.

Therefore, we the ICTDS delegates call upon the international community to conduct an International Independent Investigation into genocide, crimes against humanity, ethnic cleansing and war crimes committed by the Sri Lankan state.

Further, the ICTDS delegates call upon the international community to set up a transitional administration in the Tamil Homeland, which is situated in the North and East of the island of Sri Lanka, in order to create a protective mechanism to facilitate an accountability process and to stop the ongoing structural genocide.

We the ICTDS delegates call upon UN to conduct a referendum within the Tamil homeland and the diaspora in order for the Tamil nation to exercise its right to self-determination.
